
2022 Steinbeck* Scholarship Recipient's Thank You Stories Ana Conrad — The Eighteenth of Eighteen

The Steinbeck Memorial Fund was established in 1970 following the death of Verna (Mrs. Karl) Steinbeck. Verna was Mission Hospice Chairman of the LWML CNH for 23 years, serving as host to missionaries and their families as they passed through the San Francisco area on their way to and from foreign mission fields.

The Steinbeck Memorial Fund is specifically designed to assist in furthering the education of the children of overseas missionaries. Recipients must be high school seniors or older. Each applicant must provide a grade transcript, a brief autobiographical sketch and statement of goals.

The LWML CNH Human Care Committee vets the recipients and the BOD administers the funds. Money for this fund comes from love gifts, LWML CNH convention offerings and interest from Lutheran Church Extension Fund notes.
