

Across America, thousands of young adults who grew up in church are dating and considering marriage to a Muslim. Many of these are converting to become Muslims themselves. Look around while shopping and you will see Caucasian women wearing Muslim head covering. In





most cases the woman became Muslim by marring her Muslim husband. Christian families are devastated. The Scripture urges us that we are not to become "unequally yoked" through marriage to non-Christians (2 Cor 6:14). A growing number of young adults are dating and marrying Muslims, converting to Islam and putting themselves in painful traps of emotional and physical abuse, while becoming estranged from families, the church and Christ.
